### **Overview**

Scriptwriters-Houston, in collaboration with the National Museum of Funeral History present theatrical works inspired by the various exhibits at the museum. There will be five ten-minute plays performed in the museum. The audience will be led through a guided tour of the of each performance, starting at 3:00 pm. Each play will be performed to allow the audience to see each play once.

## **Playwrights' Guidelines**

- 1. Scripts should be 8-10 minutes long. Please confirm timing through a reading. Scripts too long or too short will be disqualified.
- 2. Script should be loosely based on the museum's exhibit. To see the exhibits, visit the museum at 415 Barren Spring Dr., Houston 77090 or their website <a href="www.nmfh.org">www.nmfh.org</a>
- 3. The language should be suitable for all ages. This is important because this a public space and is family oriented.
- 4. Script should not require costume changes, stage set changes, lighting or sound cues. Your stage is the exhibit itself.
- 5. Your script should have no more than 3 characters. Actors can play multiple roles but remember there is no space for costume changes.
- 6. The exhibits should not be moved, rearranged and touched in any way.

# Where to Submit

- 1. Scripts in PDF format should be emailed to <a href="mailto:scriptwriters.houston@gmail.com">scriptwriters.houston@gmail.com</a> by midnight on July 29th.
- 2. MUSEUM Entry should be in the subject line.
- 3. There is no submission fee for paid SWH members. This is one of the benefits of being a member at only \$35/year, consider joining if you are not a member.
- 4. There will not be an honorarium for use your script.
- 5. Scripts should have a separate page with you name, phone, email, the title of your script and the following statement:

"I have read and understand the submission guidelines and deadline. I accept the terms of submitting my work to the Scriptwriters/Houston's 2023 Museum Plays. (Insert playwright's name) I also give permission to Scriptwriters/Houston to make a recording of my play as produced by Scriptwriters/Houston and grant to Scriptwriters/Houston License to use that recording to promote Scriptwriters/Houston, by way of public/electronic media, including but not limited to YouTube, Facebook, email attachment, or by way of a television, film or radio broadcast, or podcast."
